Operator in Charge Report

Water plant and distribution systems are running well. Marty has worked with the state for help on the lead service line inspection and he has been given a coach to assist in the process of completing forms online. Work on the tanks and wells as requested by the state inspection has been completed and documentation has been uploaded. We are having intermittent chlorine pump issues due to continued high water usage which happens every winter when we are selling a lot of water; Marty is still repairing these pumps. Marty discussed water main break which happened in early April which is affected one homeowner; still working on cleanup from break. Terry and Marty are still looking at replacing the remainder of the water meters left to be replaced and change out the one that isn't working.

Operations Coordinator Report

Terry responded to four (4) 811 calls after conferring with the Water Operator. Terry met with the bookkeeper to discuss a few items. Terry assisted 3 homeowners during the snow storm and picked up their payments due to inability to make it to the pump house. Terry has ordered the fish and microbes; we might get catfish if others have requested the catfish. Fish delivery is in May and microbes should arrive before then. Terry attended an ADA compliance streamline zoom meeting.
